George Christopher Deighton is son of William Deighton & Mary Stone. William Deighton was born in England. William Deighton died in Lennox and Addington, Ontario on Nov. 8, 1871. Note: William & Mary may have married young, likely around 13 or 14.

Charles Deighton indicated he was a *Glass Packer* on his *Marriage Certificate*

In 1913, the family lived on 2nd street, Somersworth, New Hampshire, USA

In 1918 & 1919, the family lived at 7 Summer street, Somersworth, New Hampshire, USA

\* On a Jan. 15 1919 birth certificate (unknown child), it indicates this was Joseph & Herminise 6th child

The family emigrated to the USA after 1909 and return to Canada between 1919 & 1935

Herminise signs on her marriage record: *Herminise Artemise Cousineau*. Joseph doesn't know how to sign, but his brother Théodore signs the record

Ozanie Joseph Nadeau, born around 1637 in *Genouillac, Charente, France*, emigrated to New France in 1661

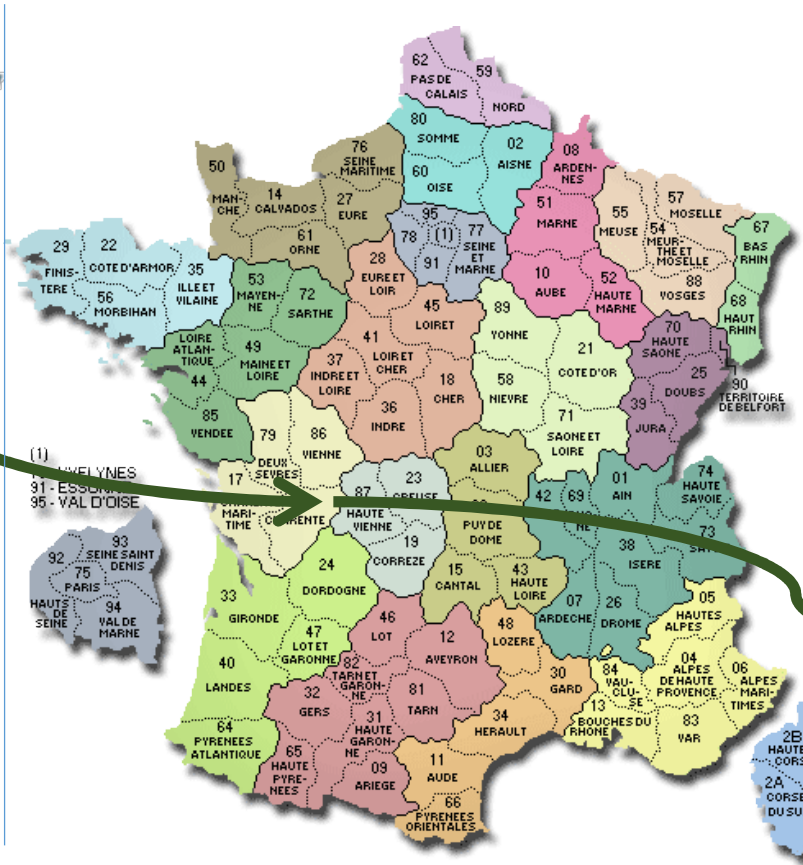
Marguerite Abraham, born on January 5, 1637 in *Saint-Eustache, Paris, France*, emigrated to New France in 1665. She came to New France as part of the wave of approximately 800 women that emigrated (from 1663 to 1673) under the program the **King's Daughters** (*filles du roi*), which was sponsored by King Louis XIV: [https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/King%27s\\_Daughters](https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/King%27s_Daughters)

Marguerite Abraham emigrated to New France onboard the ship entitled "Le St Jean-Baptiste de Dieppe" and arrived in Quebec city on the June 18, 1665 among 90 other women & King's Daughters. She had with her a dowry of 100 pounds, 50 of those pounds provided by the King:
